
What Uniform Parts Should I Purchase?

Web belt (Blue) \$8 It is the right size for the belt loops they will earn

Approximate total \$42

Once you have those items, feel free to add other things, or put them on a birthday or holiday wish list.

Other things include:

Red vests for patches \$15

Neckerchief and slides \$6 / \$4

Hats \$13

Pants \$25

Socks \$6
